Don't Miss the Fun and Joyful Things in Life

The great architect Frank Lloyd Wright was fond of an incident that may have seemed insignificant at the time but had a profound influence on the rest of his life. The winter he was 9, he went walking across a snow-covered field with his reserved, no- nonsense uncle. As the two of them reached the far end of the field, his uncle stopped him. He pointed out his own tracks in the snow, straight and true as an arrow's flight, and then young Frank's tracks meandering all over the field.

"Notice how your tracks wander aimlessly from the fence to the cattle to the woods and back again," his uncle said. "And see how my tracks aim directly to my goal. There is an important lesson in that."

Years later the world-famous architect liked to tell how the experience had contributed to his philosophy in life. "I determined right then," he'd say with a twinkle in his eye, "not to miss the things in life that my uncle had missed."

Rev. Leonard Sweet observes: "Frank LloydWright saw in those tracks what his uncle could not: It is easy to let the demands of life keep us from the joys of living. We all recognize that any goal in life worth achieving demands a great deal of our energy. We could not live if we did not set goals and work to fulfill them. No sane person would argue otherwise.

But here's what young Wright discovered at the tender age of 9, and what some don't learn until 59: The objective in life is not the goal but the journey on the way to the goal."

He's right! True success in life is not reaching the goal...it's the journey! Human relationship and motivation speaker and author Dale Carnegie used to say, *"People rarely succeed unless they have fun in what they are doing."*

Jesus knew that! He took time out to go to wedding feasts and to just enjoy time with his disciples and other friends...like hanging out with Mary, Martha, and Lazarus in their home.

He wants us to do the same! Life throws so much at us. Deal with it, of course. And take our responsibilities seriously, of course. Do what we need to do in our work and for our families. But don't get so focused on the things we have to do that we miss the joy of the journey, the things we enjoy doing, and the people we enjoy being with!

Dare I say: "Frankly, that's the Wright way to live!"?

(Bad pun, I know. But you get the idea!)

Have you heard about the video series, "The Chosen"?


