If Jesus had not risen...he would not be alive.


If he were not alive...he could not be with us.

The seasons of the church year (Advent, Christmas, Time after Epiphany, Lent, The Three Days, Easter, and Time after Pentecost) offer us the opportunity to focus on different of God's continuing work aspects in the world, the love and teachings of Christ, and the power of the Holy Spirit in our lives.
