

### CONNECTIONS

Rev. David Kalas tells the story about meeting a colleague of one day for lunch. He says:

"We live three hours apart, so we picked a little family-style restaurant that was in a small-town about halfway between our two locations. Neither of us had been to that restaurant before, but it was the perfect location –and we hoped the food would be good, too.

I arrived a few minutes early, parked my car, and went up to the door. I figured I would get a table for the two of us and watch for my friend to arrive. When I got to the door, I found a sign indicating that they were closed on Mondays. Who knew? So, I went back to my car and waited for my friend to arrive. I figured we'd be able to find some alternative nearby once we were together.

I read for a while, and about forty-five minutes after our scheduled meeting time, my phone rang. It was my friend. I greeted him cordially, but with the assumption that he was calling to explain why he was so late. After a moment of awkward conversation, it became clear that he was calling me to see why I was so late!

Because the restaurant was on a corner at the intersection of the roads he and I had traveled... from different directions...he was parked on the other side of the restaurant waiting for me! He had gone up to the door on his side, made the same discovery I had, and decided to sit in his car and wait for me. There we had been, so near to each other, but not quite making the connection!"

We all have things like that happen at times and we don't quite make connections. Sometimes that happens between us and Jesus! He wants to talk with us, but we're too busy, "not there yet", "at the wrong door", not watching for him, not listening, too distracted by life, and not paying attention. Result? We don't quite make the connection. We miss seeing him, talking with him, and hearing what he wants to say to us. That's sad. And the longer we wait to make connections with him, the easier it is to get out of the habit and find ourselves living without him.

But the good news is...this month, it's Easter! We are celebrating the truth that Jesus rose from the dead and is alive! He's wanting to connect with us. And because he's still alive, he can!

Our Lord will wait on you and watch for you. He really wants to get with you! It'll be great! Don't wait too long! Rather than just wait on him, try making a new connection yourself. Today!

As before, we will be studying the Daily Discipleship which follow the weekly lectionary.


Pastor Tom will be leading the Bible Study and ALL ARE WELCOME!
